Reflection on goals; learning gains in the lowest quartile have added tutors (70 students in tutoring) and revamped intervention block. Working closely with coaches and tracking students progress and PD's. Fifth grade will have an extra teacher along with Ms. Evans support. Increase in teacher collaboration time to 40 minutes daily, increase in intervention time no one to be pulled to interrupt the intervention time, improving attendance.
