Murray Principal: Mr. Schwarm presented about orientations, they started auditioning for the Center of the Arts in February, and the auditions are open to any rising 6<sup>th</sup> grader interested in musical extracurricular activities.

They sent out acceptances for 115 students. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders took the students on tours, to lunch, and through classrooms. The students explained the changes from elementary to middle. There was a parent orientation the same night and the parents received information about Murray. The school is used for many activities outside of the school settings. They are partnered with St. John's Middle athletics and PAL. They have a positive behavior incentive and use Live School-digital rewards system where they can spend "coins" at a school store. They have large positive incentives-Madden video game day afterschool, Dessert Wars with judges, dodgeball tournaments, and the Jags reading reward trip. MMS is departmentalized- students have 7 teachers working with each student, organization is key, they use AVID bulldog binders, planners, and interactive notebooks.
