The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring system that is administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your student will take the Kindergarten, Grade 1 or Grade 2 Renaissance Star Early Literacy, Star Reading, and/or Star Math assessment(s) on:

Kindergarten: STAR Early Literacy December 4th, STAR Math December 5th

1st Grade: STAR Early Literacy December 11th, STAR Math December 12th

2nd Grade: STAR Reading December 3rd, STAR Math December 9th

Your student's results from PM2 are for informational purposes only, and you will be provided with information about how to access the results after testing is completed.

FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get easier or more difficult depending on how the student responds, and each student will see different questions. 
