Hello Wildcat Families,

It is hard to believe that we are getting so close to summertime! Before we can really celebrate, all of us need to get through testing season together. For both students and parents, this can be a stressful time of year. It is incredibly important that your child sees you as a calm, supportive member of their educational team. If it seems your student is having some worries about their upcoming testing, try some of the strategies below.

Ask your child what is making him/her nervous. Sometimes, just saying it out loud can bring some relief. It also allows you to understand and make a plan for how to help.

Give a preview of the testing format. If your child is in grades 3-5, they have taken a practice FSA in all areas in which they will be tested. This can be found on the FSA portal. Reviewing at home with your child will again give them a sense that you are in the loop and on their school team.

Build up their confidence! Give honest praise wherever it is due. Remind your child that they can be successful no matter the outcome of their test. As the test gets closer, praise your child as much as you can. This will help them remember the feeling of success when they're feeling anxious.

Help him/her feel their best on test day.

Getting enough sleep, maintaining routines, and having a filling breakfast can do wonders on test days. Slipping a note in their bag to remind them how great they are will remind them you are with them all day!

Debrief after the test. Talk to your child after the test. Talking about how it went can give your child a sense of control and help him/her to prepare for tests in the future. This can help reduce anxiety next time around! Thank you for supporting your student in their educational success! Please feel free to contact me with any questions you may have.
